Dear Mr. Sullivan:

I am in receipt of your letter dated May 6, 2019, as counsel to LtCol Oliver North (“Col. North”), which requests indemnification and advancement of legal fees and expenses. Pursuant to the NRA’s Bylaws and the New York Not-For-Profit Corporation Law, the NRA is under no obligation to advance any of Col. North’s legal fees and expenses. The NRA declines to do so at this time.

Separately, if Col. North intends to produce documents in his possession, custody, or control to the Senate Finance Committee¹ or any other law enforcement or investigative body, which belong to the NRA, the NRA demands that: (1) it be afforded an opportunity to review any such documents prior to production, and (2) it be afforded an opportunity to review any and all such documents that may reflect a privilege that belongs to the NRA prior to production.

I hope that this addresses your concerns.
